Hickling Class

It's been another busy week in Hickling. We've been learning a portal-style narrative in English, using actions and symbols to help us remember the storyline. The children will be 'boxing it up' and making changes to it to create their own narrative using the features. In maths, the class has become more confident in using division and have created their own problems to solve. For science, we used a 'Blooket' quiz to show our understanding of light that we have been looking at this term. Our PE lesson was once again wet, however the children still enjoyed the session with the focus on passing.

The children have also completed some more art this week, using the Blitz and Battle of Britain as inspiration to make silhouette paintings.

This week Oulton Class have been learning about The Wright Brothers as part of their inventors topic and they made their own paper aeroplanes. In Outdoor learning we continued our inventors theme and made our own inventions from things we could forage. We have been reading The Wonky Donkey, a sad tale about a hero donkey and in talk for writing we have been learning persuasive writing techniques. Reception have been

working hard practicing writing and reading their new sounds and have really enjoyed dressing up as people who help us. In Science, we have been learning about the changes in the weather and made some lovely Autumn collages for our class.

Breakfast and After School Club; If your child is attending either breakfast or after school club please can you email the office each Monday and let Mrs Marshall know which dates your child would like to attend and if possible, for after school club when you plan to collect your child.

Names; Please remember to write your child's name in all their school uniform and PE kit this helps staff to reunite lost clothing with your child.

Office hours; The office is open 8:30am – 3:30pm please leave a message on the answer phone outside of these hours

Registers; The school gate opens at 8:40am and closes at 8:45am. Registers in class are taken at 8:45am. If you arrive after 8:45am you will need to buzz the office and your child will be marked as late with the number of minutes recorded. The registers close at 8:55am arrival at 8:55am or after will be recorded as an unauthorised absence and will affect your child's attendance.

Holidays; Holiday taken during term time will not be authorised and may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice of £60 being issued per child, per parent. So for a family of four that could mean a fine of £240.00.

Wellies & Waterproofs - If possible please can all the children have wellies/waterproofs in school for outdoor learning. Their wellies/waterproofs can stay in school. Please can you name your child's wellies and waterproofs.
